Tallis Choir celebrates the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's birth with a recreation of a high mass as it might have been heard in Vienna. The concert's centrepiece is Mozart's *Coronation Mass*, and additional selections include his *Exultate Jubilate* and *Ave Verum Corpus* as well as instrumental works. Guest artists are the Talisker Players and soprano Laura Albino.

Now in its 28<sup>th</sup> season, Tallis Choir is a chamber ensemble that has earned a reputation for innovative programming and polished performances. Its repertoire ranges from Gregorian chant to contemporary choral music, and the choir frequently collaborates with distinguished artists and ensembles.

Since the spring of 2003, Peter Mahon has served as Tallis Choir's artistic director. Known as both a singer and conductor, he is a member of several outstanding Canadian choirs, including Tafelmusik and Les Violons du Roy and, as a soloist, has specialized in Baroque oratorio. In addition to the Tallis Choir, he also conducts the William Byrd Singers, a 16-voice professional chamber choir he founded in 2000.
